Kolkata: Items on sale were cheaper. Quality was better. And the result was obvious. On the first day, state government's first home-delivery stall Sufal Bangla was a huge hit among shoppers at Behala's Sahapur.

Customers queued up in front of the store right after it was inaugurated by education minister Partha Chatterjee. Potato, which was selling at Rs 14 per kg, was an instant hit. Just outside the store, vendors were selling potatoes for anything between Rs 22 and Rs 26. But as per store rule, one customer couldn't buy more than 2kg at a time.
